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Upcoming Reliance Pilots Supported by Accumulus

 Accumulus provided an update regarding upcoming reliance pilot projects that will be supported by the Accumulus platform.

Roche Pilot Supported by Accumulus (presented by Roche)

 Roche provided an overview of their reliance pilot project supported by the Accumulus platform, including feedback from National Regulatory Authorities (NRAs) on their experience using the Accumulus platform.

Questions and Discussion

Privacy and Confidentiality

- Jillian Wein Riley (Accumulus General Counsel) addressed a question about the nature of the confidentiality agreements that are put in place for projects in the Accumulus platform.
- Kevin Charest (Accumulus Chief Information Security Officer) provided an overview of the Accumulus platform's key security safeguards to ensure data protection and security.

Product

- A participant asked a question about whether there is a space in the platform that is limited to interactions among NRAs only. A representative confirmed that there is a regulator-only space in the platform to which sponsors do not have access.
- In response to a question received prior to the meeting, Bill Gibson (Accumulus Chief Technology Officer) confirmed that while Accumulus is actively exploring the use of Al / large language models (LLMs) for incorporation in the Accumulus platform in 2025 and beyond, there are no immediate plans to implement these tools in the near-term Accumulus product roadmap.
